

City Fog

Thousands of pinpoints of color are revealed within City Fog's gray scape, like the view of a metropolis from on high. This unique effect is produced by the artist's layering technique using remnants from 15 reclaimed wool sweaters of varying hues. The pieces are then felted together using an industrial felting machine, with the fibers becoming integrated and interwoven throughout. Like all Wallworks, City Fog is as intriguing from afar as it is close up.
